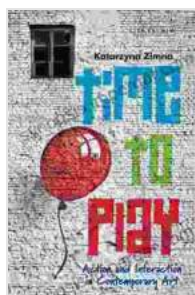

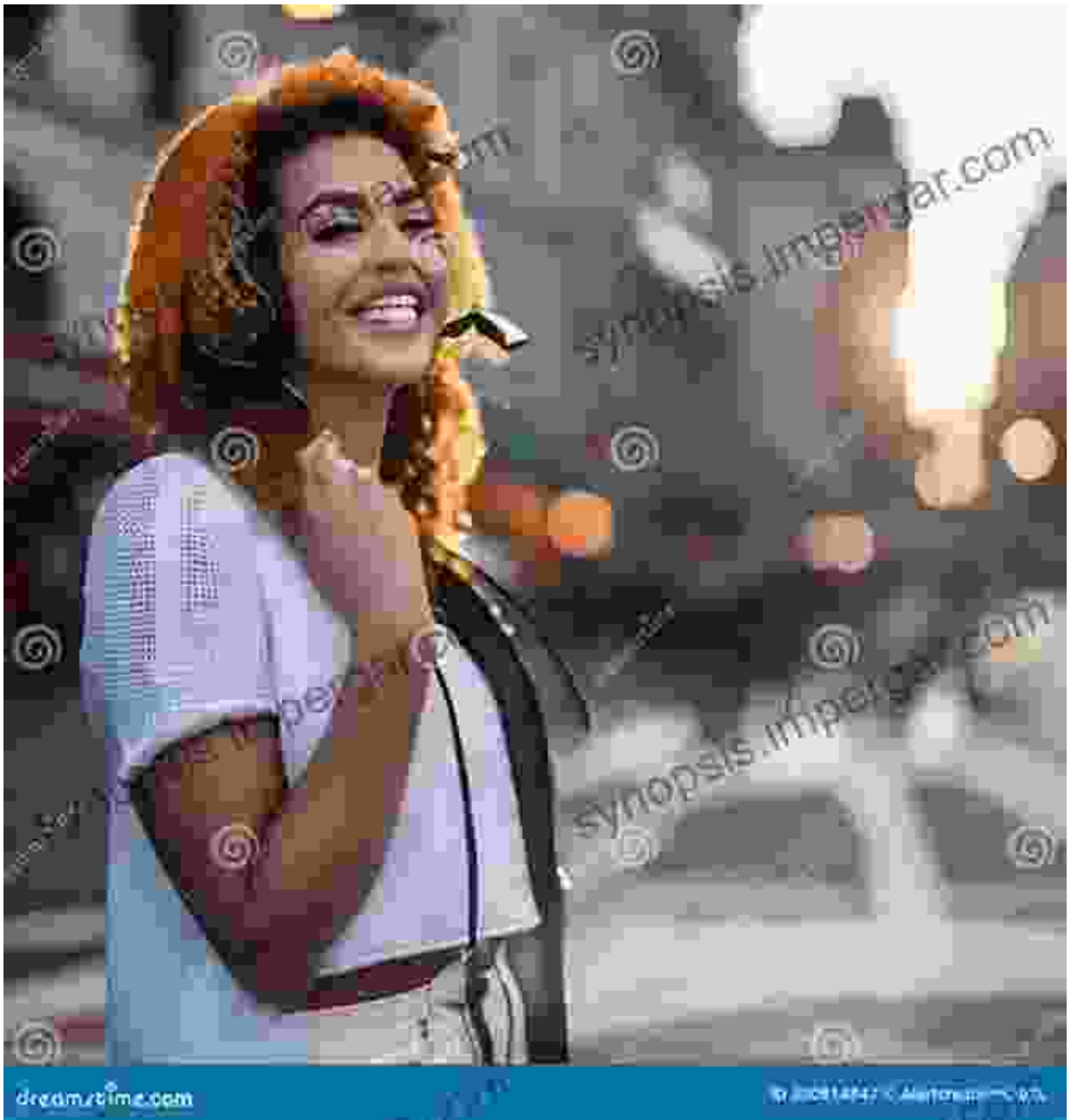
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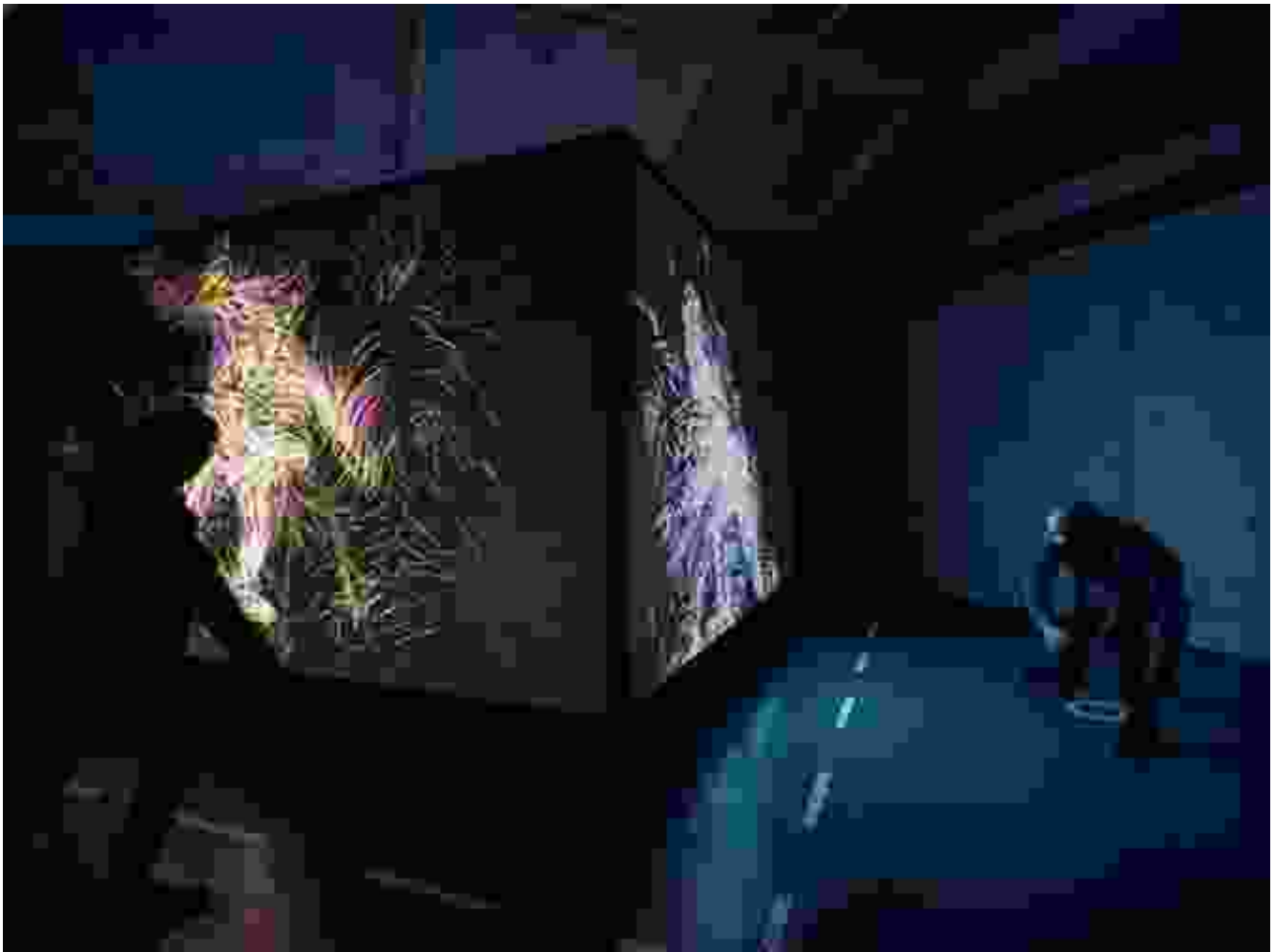

### **Interactive Installations: The Power of Participation**

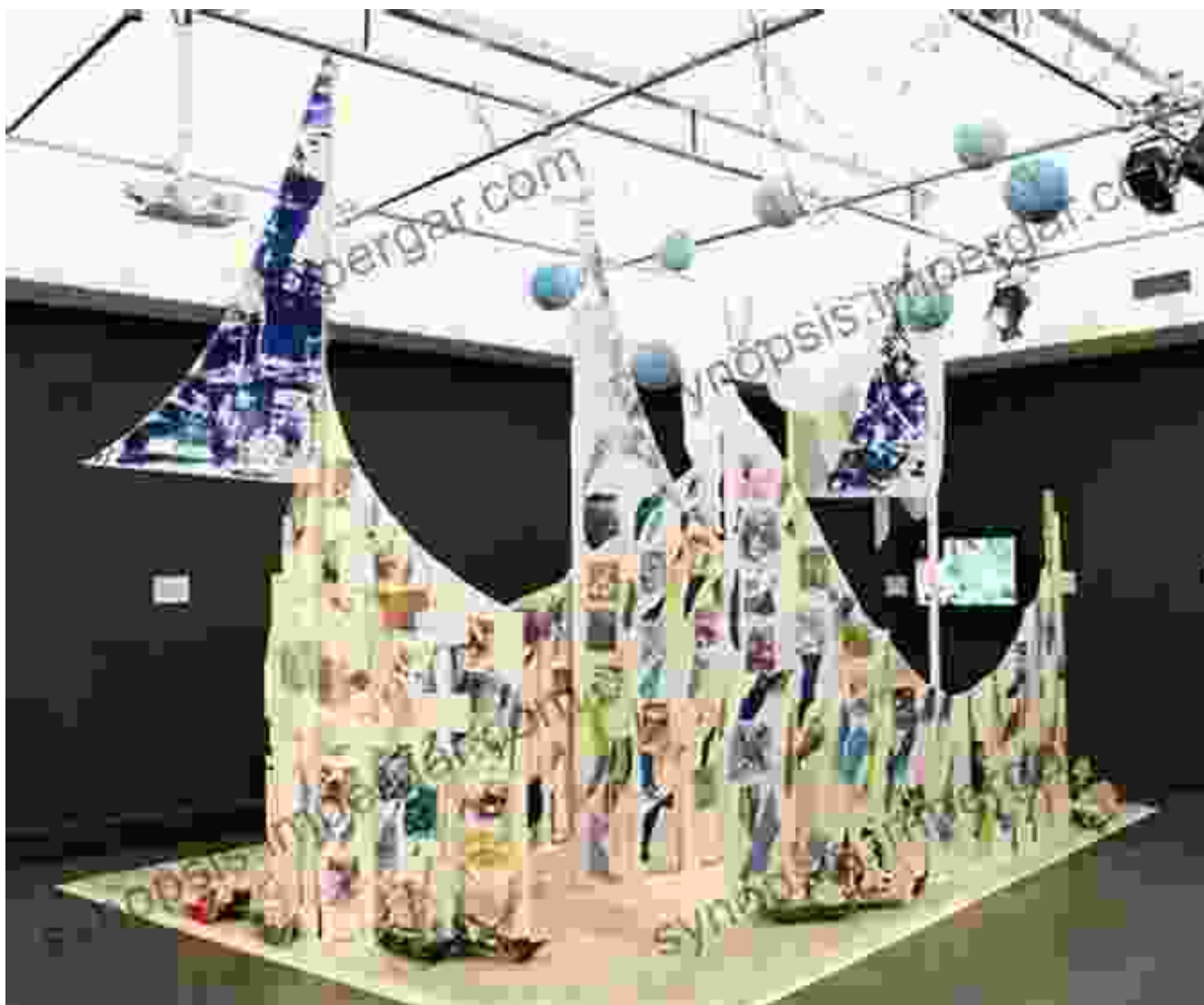

## **Redefining Artistic Expression**

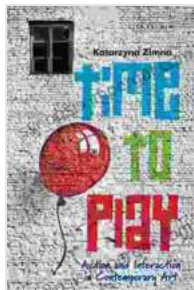

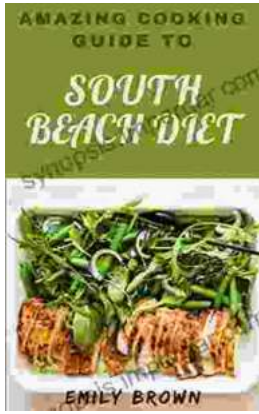
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
