




According to ontological pluralism, there is no one true ontology, but rather a plurality of ontologies, each of which is valid for a particular domain of inquiry.

Azzouni's new understanding of ontology has a number of implications for our understanding of the world. First, it means that there is no such thing as a "universal ontology" that applies to all domains of inquiry. Second, it

means that our understanding of the world is always partial and incomplete. Third, it means that we can never fully know the world, but we can always learn more about it.



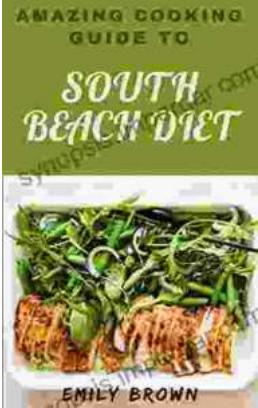
